VOTER INTEGRITY HOTLINE

St. Clair County Clerk Thomas Holbrook has created, in cooperation with St. Clair County State's Attorney James Gomric, St. Clair County Sheriff Rick Watson, Illinois Attorney General's Office, and the United States Attorney's Office, a reporting system to assist the public in reporting violations of the voting process in St. Clair County. This is an integrated system established to report violations of the voting process in St. Clair County.

Persons may email their complaints to voterintegrity@stclaircountyil.gov or provide written correspondence to the St. Clair County Clerk's Office, Attention: Election Department, 10 Public Square, Belleville, IL, 62220, or call the hotline at 618-825-2366. All emails received will be sent to the U.S. Attorney, the St. Clair County State's Attorney, St. Clair County Sheriff, and the St. Clair County Election Department automatically. All letters and complaints filed by phone at the Election Department will be documented, scanned and automatically distributed through the same voter integrity email system.



St. Clair County saving tax payer's money with a new Vote by Mail process

St. Clair County Clerk Tom Holbrook announces implementation of a new Vote by Mail ballot tracking system for voters.

The new Vote by Mail service will give voters the ability to track their mailed ballots. There will be a significant savings for taxpayers with reduced postage rates.

St. Clair County Clerk Tom Holbrook and election staff will be updating their Vote-By-Mail tracking and vote by mail envelopes to add security and reduce costs for St. Clair County.

This new service with, greater St. Louis-based, KNOWiNK will process the printing and mailing of Vote by Mail ballots for all future St. Clair County elections, beginning with the April 1, 2025 Election. This process provides voters with a proprietary tracking system to allow monitoring of their ballot as it moves through the USPS system and provides us with continual reporting and auditing information. Furthermore, this saves tens of thousands in printing and mailing costs as we update our Vote-By-Mail envelopes.

The St. Clair County Clerk's Election Division has maintained a reputation for conducting fair and transparent elections and because of that, Vote-by-Mail has continued to gain the trust of more voters. Growing in number each election cycle, Vote-by-Mail popularity has steadily increased since the 2016 Presidential Election. After 2020, Vote-By-Mail rapidly expanded with updated State Laws in Illinois.

Over 20,000 Vote-by-Mail ballots have already been requested by our office for the April 1, 2025 Election. We predict potentially 25,000 or more Vote-by-Mail ballots will be requested before April.

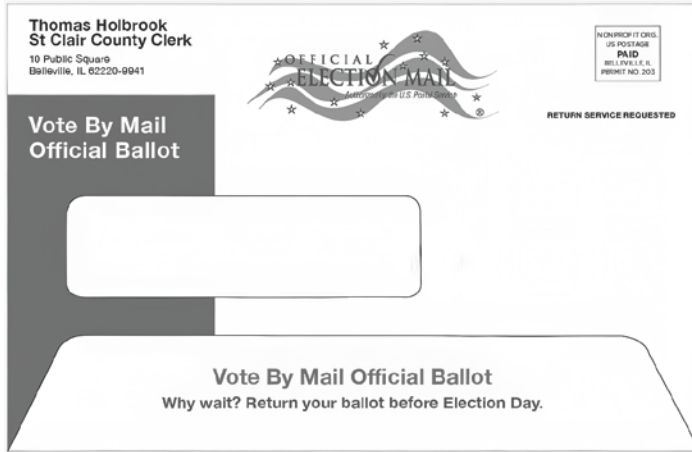
The new system will allow us to track ballots when they have been mailed out to the voters, making sure they arrive to the voters, and then allow the voters themselves to track their ballots once they have mailed the ballots back to the St. Clair County Clerk's office.

Every voter who votes by mail in St. Clair County can voluntarily track their ballot back to the County Clerk's office and confirm receipt. The entire process is being printed and fulfilled in the Greater Metro Area.

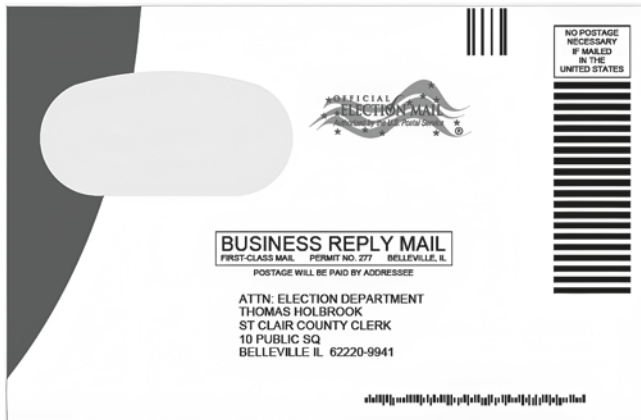
St. Clair County Clerk, Tom Holbrook and his office has continued to conduct transparent and secure elections. The office has worked to consistently look for ways to reduce costs with added benefits for the voters and taxpayers of St. Clair County.

Instructions to Vote by Mail Voters

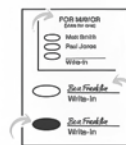
(Please follow all instructions carefully)

- With this instruction sheet you should have received the following:
1. An Official Ballot (listing candidates/offices and propositions to be voted).
 2. Return Envelope (voted ballot to be sealed inside) - On Reverse Side of Return Envelope is the Certification/Authorization section.

Read the ballot carefully noting the offices, the candidates' names, the number to be elected and any propositions; including any Constitutional Amendments, Judicial Retention questions on the ballot.

Mark the ballot in this manner:

1. Select the candidates of your choice (do not vote for more than you are entitled).
2. Opposite the name of each candidate is an oval.
3. Using a black ball point pen, completely darken the oval corresponding to the candidates of your choice and the propositions (if any) of your choice.



How to cast a write-in vote:

1. On your ballot, find the office for which the candidate is running.
2. Print the candidate's name on the Write-In line for that office.
3. Fill in the oval next to the candidate's name.

After you finish voting:

1. Insert ballot into the return envelope. Complete and sign Certification/Authorization on the back of the return envelope. Mail back to the County Clerk.
2. The ballot may be delivered in person to the Election Authority by any person who is authorized by the voter. If the voter authorized a person to deliver the ballot to the Election Authority, the voter and the person authorized to deliver the ballot shall complete the authorization printed on the return envelope.
3. Return your Ballot by mail or drop it off at the County Clerk's office at 10 Public Square, 2nd Floor, Belleville, IL 62220. A Ballot Drop Box is also located in front of the County Courthouse.

Mailed ballots will not be counted if:

1. They are postmarked later than election day, or if received in the St. Clair County Clerk's Office more than 14 days after the election.
2. If there is no signature and date on the Ballot Certification envelope.

If you spoil your ballot in any manner:

1. First call the St. Clair County Clerk's office at 618-825-2379 to confirm the ballot is indeed spoiled.
2. You may also take the spoiled ballot to your polling place on Election Day and surrender it in order to cast a new ballot.

To follow the status of your ballot, retain your stub and visit StClairBallotTrack.com and enter your Ballot Track ID listed on the stub. Or, use a smartphone and scan the QR code on the ballot stub.



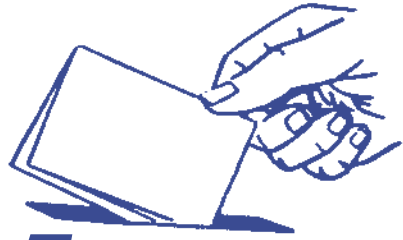
