Village of Dupo is waiting completion of the Environmental Site Assessment and results. The Village of Caseyville has been working with County staff within HEROS working towards completion of the ERR after receiving SHPO and Tribal clearance with minor stipulations to follow during construction. The County provided guidance to the City of East Saint Louis in a zoom meeting so The City could continue its procurement process. Cahokia Heights and East Carondelet are continuing environmental work and studies.

-HUD Sponsored TA has been and is in the process of reviewing The County policies and procedures to ensure policies cover requirements of the Universal Notice. The County has received feedback and incorporated the feedback in the policies.
-The County received notice on 09/30/2025 that the Waiver Request to apply the Universal Notice to the 2022 grant along with the 2024 grant was approved by HUD.

-As of 9/30/25, The County has spend a cumulative amount of \$54,693.66; \$25,000 on Planning expenses and \$29,693.66 in Administrative expenses.

Activity Description:

The project is phased into three functional design and construction phases. Phase 1 of the project, which includes green infrastructure projects to increase the level of service for flood protection, can be scaled to four level of flood control. The first level would include the construction of meandering two-stage ditch, which is the lowest cost. This ditch would serve to convey stormwater runoff through Frank Holden State Park with some attenuation and infiltration prior to discharge into Whispering Willow Lake. The second and third level would construct Cell 1and Cell 2 bio-retention and treatment trains to capture and retain stormwater from Piat Place before releasing it to the two-stage ditch for discharge into Whispering Willow Lake. A future constructed wetland project is included in the design that would provide additional storage and treatment. Phase 2 of the project will construct a trunk sewer that runs a long North 62nd Street to intersect the existing storm sewer conveying stormwater to Harding Ditch. Phase 3 of the project will replace the existing trunk sewer running along Piat Place from North 58th Street to North 62nd Street. This wll include multiple pipe diameters and will consist of an estimated total of 2,17 feet of piping.

Location Description:

The activity is located in the Piat Place Neighborhood in Cahoia Heights, IL 62203. The activity boundaries consist of Piat Place to the north, Lake Drive to the south, North 58th Street to the west, and Pittsburgh Drive to the east. The project is in BIKGRP 1, Census Tract 5029.

The goal of this project is to replace sewer trunklines and culverts in the Edgemont neighborhood in the City of East Saint Louis.
