PETITION FOR DECLARATION OF INVALIDITY OF MARRIAGE

I, _____ (*your name*), ask the court to declare my marriage to the Respondent,
_____ (*spouse's name*) invalid. The following is true:

1. We both live in _____ (*county*), Illinois.

a. Inability to Consummate

I immediately discovered after marriage that Respondent was unable to consummate the marriage by sexual intercourse. b. Fraud

Respondent fraudulently induced me to agree to marriage.
