What's next?

You are responsible for making payments even if you have an employer.

- Share your court order with your employer so they can begin to withhold directly from your paycheck.
- Note the PAYMENT DUE DATE on your order, it is YOUR responsibility to make payments! If you have an employer, you are responsible for paying until funds are deducted from your paycheck. Failure to submit timely payments may result in penalties.
