## **ABOUT THE MENTAL HEALTH BOARD**

The St. Clair County Mental Health Board is a mental health authority of the county government, and operates under the provisions of H.B. 708, Illinois Revised statutes, also known as the Community Mental Health Act 405 ILCS 20/3e.

The St. Clair County Mental Health Board was created by referendum approved by the voters of St. Clair County in 1965. Through the passage of this referendum, a property tax levy was established to support the Mental Health Board's mission to assure that a comprehensive and coordinated system of effective and efficient public mental health services is available and accessible to all of the citizens of St. Clair County in need of such services. The legislation empowers the Mental Health Board to develop and coordinate a local system of care addressing the needs of our residents living with mental illness, substance use disorders, or an intellectual and/or developmental disability.

## **COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH ACT MANDATES & DUTIES**

- The development of local plans for the most efficient delivery of mental health, substance use disorder, and intellectual and/or developmental services.
- Prepare and submit an annual budget of expenses.
- Within amounts appropriated therefore, execute such programs, and maintain such services and facilities as authorized under such appropriations.
- Review and evaluate community mental health services and facilities, including the treatment of mental illness, drug addiction, and intellectual and/or developmental disabilities.
- Prepare and submit an annual budget for expenses and publish annually a report of the budget showing the condition of its trust that year.
- Submit a one-and-three-year plan to the County Board.

The following information serves as the 2024 Annual Report and includes the year-end financial statements, highlights of funded initiatives, and demographics of those served.
