Upon a motion by Mr. O'Donnell and seconded by Mr. Greenwald, it was unanimously agreed to approve Transportation Resolution #3162-26-RT – Authorizing a Permit to ADB Companies, LLC to Install a Communication Line Along Frank Scott Parkway 604 Feet Along the Park Property.

Upon a motion by Mr. Greenwald and seconded by Mr. Baricevic, it was unanimously agreed to approve Transportation Resolution #3163-26-RT – Authorizing the County Engineer to Purchase Two (2) 2027 International Tandem Dump Trucks with Snowplow Attachments in the Amount of \$399,805.06.

Upon a motion by Mr. Greenwald and seconded by Mr. Baricevic, it was unanimously agreed to approve Transportation Resolution #3164-26-RT – Authorizing Hurst-Roche to Prepare a Bridge Condition Report for the Hartman Lane Bridge Over Richland Creek in the Amount of \$8,400.

Upon a motion by Mr. Baricevic and seconded by Mr. Greenwald, it was unanimously agreed to approve Transportation Resolution #3165-26-RT – Authorizing the Vacation of Resolution #3077-25-RT and Authorizing the County Engineer to Purchase a Used "In Stock" Rotary Cutter in the Amount of \$20,000.
